PROGRAMS NOW IN PLACE TO ASSIST HOMEBOUND INDIVIDUALS AND THOSE WITH MOBILITY ISSUES GET THE COVID-19 VACCINE

Mayor Ben Zahn announced that COVID-19 vaccinations are available through JenCare in Kenner as part of a new program that provides transportation so that individuals with mobility issues can get the COVID vaccine.

The Paratransit Vaccination Program is one of two COVID-19 vaccination services announced Monday by Jefferson Parish.

Residents can contact a call center at 504-518-4020 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, to make an appointment to get the Johnson & Johnson vaccine at a local participating healthcare facility and for more information.

In addition to JenCare in Kenner, Metairie and Gretna, other participating healthcare partners for the paratransit program are Oak Street Health in Metairie and Our Community Health in Gretna.

The Homebound Vaccination Program announced today makes a COVID-19 vaccination available for residents who are unable to leave their homes.

The homebound vaccination program also uses the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, which requires only a single shot. Responders from Ochsner Health will administer the vaccine to individuals in their homes. Residents can also contact the parish call center at 504-518-4020 for this program, during the same times Monday through Friday.
