MAYOR ZAHN LIFTS MASK MANDATE IN KENNER

Mayor Zahn has ordered that beginning on Wednesday, April 28, the proclamation now in place that requires masks to be worn in all settings in the city will be lifted. This follows the new mandate from Gov. John Bel Edwards.

However, residents still will be required to wear masks on public transit, in health care facilities and in all K-12 schools, colleges and universities, as required by the governor's office.

Since many government buildings are maintaining a mandate to wear masks, residents and visitors will be required to wear masks in all city buildings, including City Hall, the Pontchartrain Center, public libraries, recreational facilities and all Kenner fire departments.

Residents should follow the recommendations from the CDC to wear masks in indoor settings and in large outdoor crowds. Local businesses can require that patrons and workers wear masks, if they choose. Anyone who is not yet vaccinated should continue to follow safety guidelines including social distancing and wearing masks.
